Mission

To provide safe haven and life changing programs to help abused women, their children and families rebuild their lives – and work with the community to break the cycle of domestic violence.

Outcomes & Impact

We impact the lives of over 20,000 Orange County residents annually:

- Field 2,000 emergency hotline calls from abused women
- Deliver safe haven, life changing programs to 200+ abused women and their families
- Provide counseling, legal advocacy, resources and support to 1,000+ women and their families
- Conduct 600+ prevention programs for over 12,000 local children, teens and adults

**Independent academic research consistently verifies that 90% of our residential clients continue to be violence free one year or more after graduating from the program.*

Domestic Violence Facts

- 1-in-4 women will be physically assaulted by a partner during her lifetime
- One-third of all 911 calls reporting domestic violence are made by children
- Children who grow up in homes with domestic violence are more likely to become abusers or be abused
- 1-in-5 teens will experience dating violence
- 90% of elder abuse is committed by a family member
- The cost of domestic violence to American business is \$6B annually in medical leave and lost productivity
