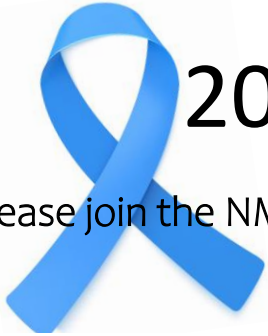

History

In 1989, a grandmother in Virginia tied a blue ribbon to the antenna of her car in memory of her grandson who died as a result of child abuse. The blue ribbon was used to pay tribute to her grandson and to spread awareness in her community. Decades later, our country continues to use a blue ribbon to pay tribute to children who have died as a result of child abuse. The Blue Ribbon also represents individuals, organizations, and communities that work towards preventing child abuse. This year FaCT (Families and Communities Together) has chosen to use a Daisy along with the Blue Ribbon, “to symbolize the innocence and purity of children” - (FaCT Program Manager)
